Awareness camp on paddy cum fish farming held

AALO, Sep 12: One-day awareness camp on "paddy cum fish farming" was conducted by Department of Fisheries in collaboration with PRI members at Bogdo, Dego & Panya villages today.

While interacting with fish farmers and PRI members, Commissioner Fisheries Huzar Lollen highlighted the programme and policies of the department and encouraged the unemployed youth and farmers to take fisheries activities in the village for self-employment.

He also encouraged the farmers to take up the paddy cum fish farming so that their earning goesidouble. He discouraged the use of pesticides/weedicides to build more eco-friendly method.
