- (e) The Government of Arunachal Pradesh shall utilise the instalments released as per the PMMSY guidelines and submit the Utilization Certificates (UCs) as per the prescribed proforma under GFR.
- (f) The Government of Arunachal Pradesh shall ensure implementation of activities/projects under this proposal strictly in accordance with the funding pattern of the PMMSY.
- (g) The PMMSY emphasizes as far as possible 'cluster or area-based development' to enhance competitiveness of fisheries sector, facilitate economies of scale, generate higher incomes, accelerate growth and expansion of the fisheries sector in an organized manner, amplify outcomes, etc. The Government of Arunachal Pradesh will identify potential growth clusters/areas, integrate the approved activities/projects and take up cluster based development of fisheries and aquaculture as far as possible.

- (p) The Government of Arunachal Pradesh shall ensure timely availability of the States hare as well as beneficiary share for smooth and timely implementation of the activities/projects and to avoid cost and time overruns.
